All products have a Colour Screen, built-in GPS and NMEA0183 connectivity.

The “Plus” versions feature a brighter screen and updated software compared to the previous versions.

“Screen” is the standard diagonal size.

“Inc Trdx” indicates whether a Depth Transducer is included in the package. DB indicates a traditional Dual-Beam transducer, GT20 indicates a combined Traditional/ClearVü CHIRP transducer.

“UK” Charts indicates the whole of the UK (including most major inland waterways), northern France and the west coast of Belgium and The Netherlands.

“2000” indicates NMEA2000 connectivity.
